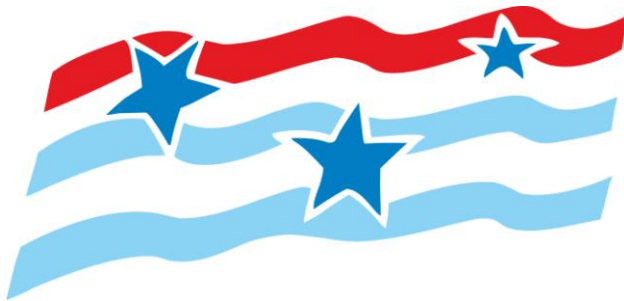


Tuesday, February 1st

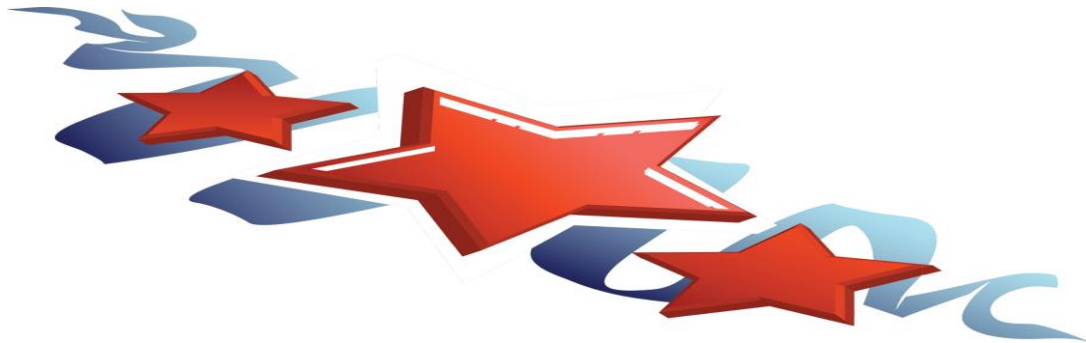
